

NOTICES AND PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CLAIMS OF COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §201.38 and §512 of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. §512(c), you may notify Binge, LLC of an infringing work by submitting the following information in writing to our designated agent:

- 1) A physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.
- 2) Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed, or if multiple copyrighted works at a single online site are covered by a single notification, a list of such works at that site.
- 3) Identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing or to be the subject of infringing activity and that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit Binge, LLC to locate the material.
- 4) Information reasonably sufficient to permit Binge, LLC to contact you, such as an address, telephone number, and if available, an email address at which you may be contacted.
- 5) A statement that you have a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent or the law.
- 6) A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.
